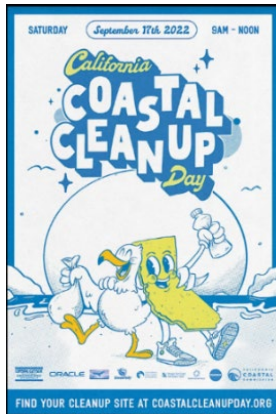

Metrolink Service Update:

Beginning Friday, September 16, a nationwide work stoppage by freight railroad worker unions may impact Metrolink service. Portions of the Orange County, Inland Empire-Orange County, 91/Perris Valley, Riverside and Ventura County lines may be impacted. According to Metrolink, there is a likelihood that
