**Skatepark Project Update:** Design of the City's skatepark and trail connection project is now complete, and the City Council will consider approval of the project at its April 5 meeting. The project site is located in the southwest corner of the City-owned Kinoshita Farm property (operated by The Ecology Center) and adjacent to the Sports Park complex. Project elements include a 20,000 square foot skatepark, restroom, farm-themed play structure, new multi-use trail connecting Via Positiva to Camino Del Avion, shade structures and seating area. Pending City Council approval of the project, construction is anticipated to begin July 2022.



**Camino Capistrano Pavement Rehabilitation Project:** In October 2021, the City Council approved an enhanced Streets Improvement Program spending plan that allocated \$7 million in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds, along with other sources, to the existing annual budget for street repair. As part of the enhanced spending plan, the City Council also expanded the scope of work for the Camino Capistrano Rehabilitation Project to include the entire length of Camino Capistrano, from Dana Point to Laguna Niguel city limits. Staff has completed the design of the project and will be recommending

City Council approval to advertise for construction bids at its April 5 meeting. Construction is anticipated to begin in July 2022, with the estimated project completion in Fall 2022. Additionally, as part of the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Budget Workshop taking place May 7, the City Council will be considering future street rehabilitation project opportunities for fiscal years 2024 through 2029.

**Newly Adopted City Council District Map Available Now:** Following several public hearings to receive input from the community, at its March 15 meeting the City Council adopted an ordinance approving the newly-drawn City Council district map. The City will also be providing free special event trolley service for the event from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. that includes two 20-minute loops serving San Juan Capistrano communities north and south of the Downtown and Los Rios Park.
