SUBJECT: Weekly Update

Spring Street and El Camino Real Improvements: This month, the City will begin construction of the grant-funded “Spring Street and El Camino Real Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Improvement Project.” The project includes reconstruction of five existing pedestrian access ramps at the intersections of Ortega Highway and El Camino Real as well as Spring Street and El Camino Real, repaving deteriorated sections of pavement with a new widened sidewalk at the southeast corner of Spring Street and El Camino Real, and the relocation of an existing mid-block crosswalk (on El Camino Real), currently situated directly in front of San Juan Elementary School. These improvements will provide for improved pedestrian access in this heavily traveled area. Construction is anticipated to be completed this August, prior to the start of the school year.



San Juan Summer Nites Concert – June 15: Join us from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 15, for the kick-off of the *San Juan Summer Nites* concert series at Historic Town Center Park (31525 El Camino Real).
