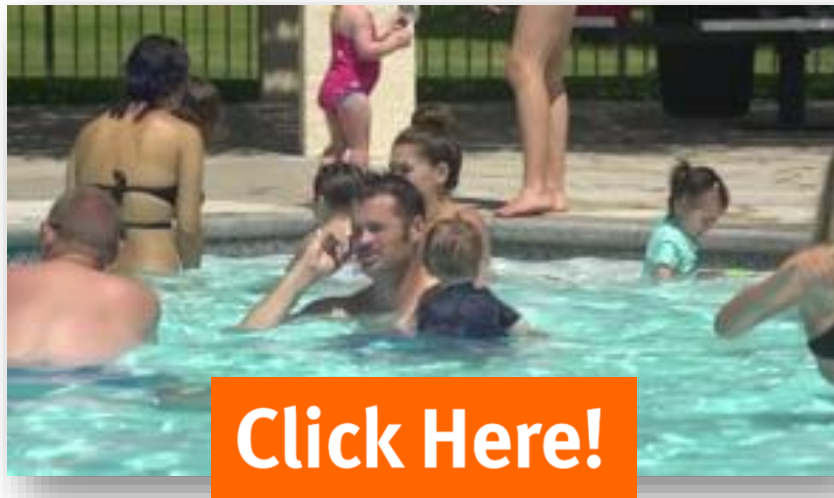
SUBJECT: Weekly Update

Skatepark Project Update: Design of the City's skatepark and trail connection project is underway. The project site is located in the southwest corner of the City-owned Kinoshita Farm property adjacent to the Sports Park complex. Project elements include a 20,000 square foot skatepark, restroom, farm-themed play structure, new multi-use trail connecting Via Positiva to Camino Del Avion, shade structures and grass berm seating. The design progress was presented to the Parks, Equestrian and Community Services Commission on July 19 and final design plans are anticipated to be approved by the City Council in Fall 2021. The project is expected to be complete next summer.
