Skatepark Environmental Document Public Review: This week, the Planning Commission considered the City Skatepark Project located at the southwest corner of the Kinoshita Farm property (near the Sports Park) and recommended City Council approval. The project will include a 20,000 square foot all-wheel skatepark, playground structure, restroom building, shaded seating areas and landscaping. In addition, the proposed project includes a new multi-use public trail along Via Positiva and the western edge of the Kinoshita Farm property that would connect The Farm residential development, currently under construction adjacent to the project site, to the new skatepark and Camino Del Avion. Prior to City Council consideration of the project in April, an additional public review period will be available for the project's environmental document. OCTA Alerts Bus Passengers of Potential Strike: The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) has been notified by the OCTA Coach Operators' Union, whose members operate County bus service, that they may strike as soon as Tuesday, February 15. According to OCTA, negotiations to reach an agreement that will avoid any disruption in service are ongoing. However, due to the possibility of a strike, OCTA encourages riders to begin to plan for alternative transportation arrangements. If a strike occurs, bus service may continue operating on select routes. OC ACCESS paratransit same-day taxi services for people with disabilities and OC Flex micro transit services will not be affected. Metrolink train service will also operate as usual. Participate in the 2022 City Council Redistricting Process: Every ten years, following the decennial U.S. Census, voting district boundaries are redrawn to account for any changes in population. Redistricting helps ensure that communities have equal access to political representation. As part of this effort, the City of San Juan Capistrano will be holding public hearings for residents to contribute to the process.
