On Friday, September 22, the City of San Juan Capistrano and Orange County Sheriff's Department honored the life and memory of Deputy Brian Haney, who passed away on February 9, 2023. Deputy Haney, who was assigned to San Juan Capistrano Police Services, was a six-year veteran of the Orange County Sheriff's Department and a member of the Critical Incident Response Team. To commemorate his service and dedication to our community, the City Council approved the dedication of a flagpole and memorial boulder located at the Community Center. Deputy Haney is survived by his wife Leslee and son Cole.

On September 23, the City of San Juan Capistrano participated in the Annual California Coastal Cleanup event. The event was held at Descanso Park with 122 participants working to remove litter from San Juan Creek and Arroyo Trabuco Creek. The event was supported by the City's Youth Advisory Board, Rotary Club, and Public Works Department. Additionally, community group Ryan's Recycling Project supplied items such as pails, trash pickers, and hats. Through their efforts, approximately 1,100 pounds of trash and debris were collected. The private property owner of the Playhouse Parking Lot (26874 Old Mission Road) will begin implementing paid parking tomorrow, Friday, September 29. The eastern section of this lot, known as the Gateway Parking Lot, is City-owned and offers 25 free public parking spaces. Additionally, the City provides free parking options at the Los Rios Park and Ramos Street Parking lots, offering a combined total of 265 spaces for public and downtown employee use.
